**Sumitomo Mitsui Banking Corporation and Turkiye Garanti Bankasi sign
Co-operation Agreement**

TOKYO, February 13, 2013 --- Sumitomo Mitsui Banking Corporation (“SMBC”, President and CEO: Takeshi Kunibe) and Turkiye Garanti Bankasi A.S. (“Garanti Bank”, President and CEO: Ergun Özen) announced today the signing of a Co-operation Agreement on banking and financial services in Turkey on February 12, 2013.
