## SMBC commits additional support for COVID-19 emergency relief and recovery efforts in India

TOKYO, May 31, 2021— As part of its response to the ongoing COVID-19 related situation in India, Sumitomo Mitsui Banking Corporation ("SMBC", President and Group CEO: Makoto Takashima) is committing an additional Rs 65 million (JPY 96 million) to deliver ongoing relief to affected communities in India. - Supply oxygen concentrators to hospitals;
- Equip hospital intensive care units with additional ventilators; and
